## **CALL FOR ABSTRACTS**

Abstracts are invited for both oral and poster presentations. Deadlines are shown on the website. Notification of acceptance, whether poster or oral, will be no later than the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

## **Guidelines for submitting an abstract**

Authors are asked to follow these guidelines when submitting an abstract for oral or poster presentation:

- Abstracts should be no longer than two A4 pages in portrait layout and Arial type, font size 12
- The title of the abstract should be as concise as possible and appear in bold type, lower case and centred
- Co-Authors and affiliations are to be presented below the title in italics where the main author(s) name(s) should be underlined and the name of the presenting author should be marked with an asterisk (e.g., Jones\*)
- Main body of text to be left aligned
- Single spacing throughout
- References, denoted by superscript numbers in the text should be listed at the end of the text using standard Chemical Abstracts Source Service Index terminology followed by Year, Volume, and Page.
- The use of figures, graphs, pictures and schematics is recommended where this aids the understanding of the text, but should be kept to a minimum.
- Abstracts should be sent as an MS Word email attachment to Dr Nick Evans (nick.evans@ntu.ac.uk) with the subject line "NRC10 ABSTRACT"

Please include the full name and address and contact details of the main author and the presenting author in the email and clearly indicate whether you are submitting an oral or a poster presentation.

Please note there is a 10MB limit for on-line abstract submission. If your abstract is large, reduce the file size by compressing the images. If the file size is still too large, then contact the secretariat and an alternative email address will be provided.
